



Banrisul receives national award in IT Management

Banrisul was granted last week in Sao Paulo, during Ciab Febraban (IT Congress for Financial Institutions, sponsored by the Federation of Brazilian Banks), five awards in the areas of security, information technology and social management. Rubens Bordini, the Bank's Vice-President and Chief Information Officer, also received the 2010 E-Finance Executive of the Year prize in the special category of Best IT Manager.

The executive was acknowledged for his performance and contribution to implementing new projects. For Bordini, the award is a recognition of the state-of-art IT management model developed by Banrisul. "It represents the more than nine thousand employees that have been working in line with the new concepts of technology and sustainability," he added.

The winning categories, with six cases, were: 1) category Social Action: case *Responsibility on All Sides*; 2) category Telecommunications Management: cases *Overcoming the barrier of the MPLS backbone, ensuring the management of your Wan network* and *High Availability, Security and Flexibility: Banrisul's Reality*; 3) category Digital Identity: case *Digital Identity*; 4) category IT Governance: case *Strategic IT Management*; and 5) category Risk Management: case *Managing risk, building trust*.
